An email will be sent to your personal email address that Laidlaw College has in its Student Management System, and this will include a link to your My eQuals account.

ACADEMIC DRESS

- You must wear academic dress to graduate.
- You can hire your regalia from The Graduation Place see information below.
- This is a formal occasion, and suitable attire should be worn underneath your regalia, with appropriate footwear. Please bear in mind that you will be accessing the stage via steps during the ceremony.
- Laidlaw College will provide all ACADEMIC HOODS at the pre-graduation get-together on Friday 23 May or from 10am on Saturday 24 May at Church Unlimited.
- You can hold on to your Academic Hood for up to one week after Graduation. A bond of \$100 is required at the time of collection, which will be refunded in full when the hood is returned.

OTHER COSTS

When ordering regalia online, all graduands are given the option to donate \$5.00 to the Kate Edger Educational Charitable Trust.

Laidlaw graduands will not be required to pay a bond, however, any regalia returned after Tuesday 27 May will incur late fees.

Optional - Hassle-free pickup and return service: Shipping recommended to avoid queues and parking issues. Your regalia will arrive 1-3 weeks prior to your ceremony. Cut off to order courier delivery is 5 business days prior to your graduation.

PRE-CEREMONY PORTRAITS:

MEDIA

Please note that photography will take place on the day of graduation (not just during the ceremony) and some of this may be used for promotional purposes.

All mobile communication devices must be silent or turned off during the ceremony. Guests are permitted to take photographs during the ceremony, provided they are considerate of other guests. We ask that guests not leave their seats to take photographs. A professional videographer will be recording the ceremony. This video will be available to all after the ceremony on the Laidlaw College website. We request that guests do not video the ceremony.
