GRADUATION CEREMONY DETAILS

The ceremony will be held at Church Unlimited, 3 Te Atatu Road, Glendene, Auckland. There will be an Academic Procession that will begin in the car park and proceed into the Church auditorium.

Graduands attending the ceremony should meet at Church Unlimited in their Academic regalia appropriate to their programme no later than 12 noon on Saturday 27 April 2019. Doors will be open from 10:30 am and photos and hoods will be available from the same time.

CARPARKING

On Saturday 27 April you are welcome to park your car in the main car park. Please do not leave valuables in your car. Please do not park in the car parks designated for the shops and in the Glendene Village area. Parking attendants will be available to guide you.

CERTIFICATES AND ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPTS

The document sleeve you receive at Graduation contains your Certificate and the official Academic Transcript. If you require additional copies of your Academic Transcript, a \$25 fee applies.

ACADEMIC DRESS

- You must wear academic dress in order to graduate (unless you are graduating from a Certificate programme).
- You can hire your regalia from **Academic Dress Hire** - see information below.
- It should be noted that on this formal occasion suitable attire should be worn underneath your regalia, with appropriate footwear. Please bear in mind that you will be accessing the stage via steps during the ceremony.
- Laidlaw College will provide all ACADEMIC HOODS at the pre-graduation get together on Friday 26 April or from 10:30 am on Saturday 27 April at Church Unlimited.

ORDER IN PERSON

Onsite orders for Laidlaw graduands are only on the following days and timings:

- Tuesday 23 April between 8:30 am and 6:00 pm
- Wednesday 24 April between 8:30 am and 5:00 pm
- Friday 26 April between 8:30 am and 5:00 pm.

Note that Academic Dress Hire will be closed on 25 April 2019 due to ANZAC day.

Please also note that Academic Dress Hire is not open on Graduation Day, Saturday 27 April 2019.

Please visit the Academic Dress Hire offices with payment ready. Note that due to the University Graduation ceremonies around the same time, Academic Dress Hire expect longer waiting times for payment and pick up. Please mention that you are ordering for the Laidlaw College Graduation Ceremony.

OTHER COSTS

When ordering regalia online, all graduands are given the option to donate \$5.00 to the Kate Edger Educational Charitable Trust.

Laidlaw graduands will not be required to pay a bond, however any regalia returned after 7:00 pm on Tuesday 30 April will incur late fees.

Optional - Hassle free return service: When ordering, graduands can purchase a postage prepaid box for \$10 for returning regalia. After the ceremony, graduands simply put regalia in the box and call NZ Couriers to arrange sending regalia back to Academic Dress Hire.

PICK UP/RETURN

Height can be indicated on the website; however, a personalised fitting is available when you go to collect your order. Print out your order confirmation and take it with you when you collect your outfit during the week before the ceremony so that they can process your order quickly. OFFICIAL PHOTOS

Various photographs can be taken of you during the day, including the moment of Graduation just after you are presented with your award.

PRE-CEREMONY PORTRAITS:

Take advantage of the professional photography services available on the day of your graduation (from 10:30 am – 12:30 pm) and sit for a portrait of yourself in your academic regalia. Couple, family and group shots are welcome. The photography studio will be positioned inside the Church auditorium.

Portraits cost \$8 per pose and include a digital image for social media. Prints can also be purchased as desired. We encourage you to pre-order and pay for your portraits before the graduation day. This can be done online at:

Please note, payment may also be made by cash on the day, but EFTPOS is not available at the venue.

Please arrive as early as possible on the day if you hope to have professional photos taken.

AWARD:

MEDIA

Please note that photography will take place on the day of graduation (not just during the ceremony) and some of this may be used for promotional purposes.

All mobile communication devices must be on silent or turned off during the ceremony. Guests are permitted to take photographs during the ceremony, provided they are considerate to other guests. We ask that guests not leave their seat in order to take photographs. A professional videographer will be recording the ceremony. This video will be available to all after the ceremony on the Laidlaw College website. We request that guests do not video the ceremony.

Your family and friends are welcome to join you for the day including photos, the procession, the ceremony and the afternoon tea. Tickets will not be required and invitations for you to forward to your guests are included.
