Founded in 1922, Laidlaw College is now New Zealand's largest theological education provider. For more than 90 years Laidlaw College (initially the Bible Training Institute and then Bible College of New Zealand) has been preparing men and women to respond to God's call on their lives. Graduates of Laidlaw can be found in positions of influence and leadership all over the world. A number are now leading church denominations and mission organisations. They are working as missionaries. They hold senior positions in the private and public sector. They are making a difference to children in primary school classrooms. They are working with the broken-hearted in counselling rooms and they serve in their local churches.

Laidlaw College is far more than just a tertiary institution. It is a community of students, staff and scholars shaped and compelled by the Gospel; a christian community deeply committed to growing disciples and raising up leaders who are rooted and established in love. The special character of the College means that we cannot solely depend on government funding, and are heavily reliant on fundraising activities in order to keep fees affordable and to fund initiatives that fall outside of our educational mandate.

We believe that strategic investments need to be made in order to secure Laidlaw's long term financial stability. This is where Laidlaw College Foundation comes in.

## **LAIDLAW COLLEGE FOUNDATION**

Established in 1986, Laidlaw College Foundation is a separate legal entity incorporated under the Charitable Trusts Act. The Foundation exists to build a capital fund that will generate income for the College for generations to come. This will enable the College to focus on training students for Christian service rather than finding additional income to service debt and other running costs.

Trustees of Laidlaw College Foundation are dedicated to seeing the College flourish long into the future and have the knowledge and experience to make wise financial investments. For more information about the Foundation and its members please visit our website: www.laidlaw.ac.nz/foundation

Bequests made to the College which are not specified for a particular purpose are added to the capital of the Foundation Trust fund. The Foundation has to date built a nett investment fund in excess of \$5 million. Laidlaw College Foundation is now seeking new investments to grow the fund and ensure that the future of the College is secure.

## WILLS AND BEQUESTS

A will is a legal document that specifies how you would like your assets distributed after your death and making a bequest is the act of giving part of your estate to an individual or to a charitable cause you wish to support or acknowledge your involvement with.

Some people choose to give a proportion of their estate (which helps protect the value of their gift); others prefer to nominate a specific dollar amount, shares or particular asset while some leave the balance of their estate once provision has been made for family (a residual bequest).

In addition to supporting the College through prayer, one-off gifts or automatic payments, you could leave a **lasting legacy** by making provision for Laidlaw College Foundation in your will.


