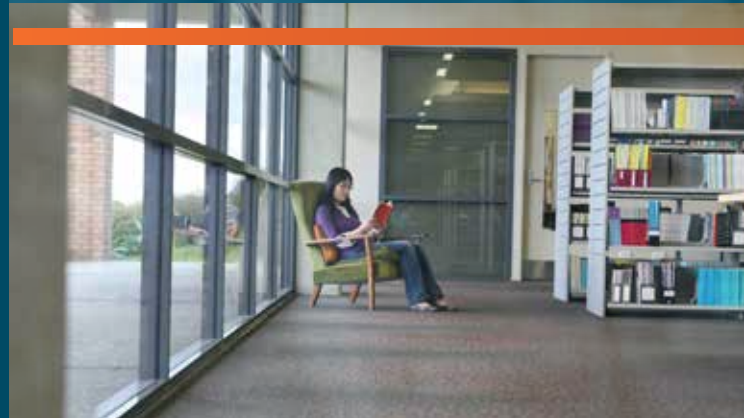

Laidlaw Graduate School students may borrow up to 30 items for 12 weeks, with the option of renewal. You can request and renew items online. You need to log in to the Catalogue to use this function. See Library staff if you need to set up a password.

Interloan Requests

Resources from other libraries throughout New Zealand can be requested via interloan. The library will process all requests on your behalf, at a cost of \$5.00 per item. However, if you are enrolled with another institution for ongoing study purposes, that institution is responsible for obtaining and processing your interloan requirements.

Postal Service

We will post up to 4 books to you at any one time. You are responsible for the return postal charges.

E-Books

We have a growing E-Book collection that can be accessed via the One Stop Search.

Simply enter the keyword "ebooks" into the basic search box on the One Stop Search screen and this will list all available titles. You can then display the full record by clicking the title, and from there you can click the URL to open the E-Book link. You will then be asked to log in using your provided username and password to access the work, which can either be read online or downloaded (Adobe Digital Editions is required for this).
